Europass documents refer to the European Qualifications Framework (EQF)

What does this mean?

EQF is a common European reference framework whose purpose is to make qualifications more **readable** and **understandable** across different countries and systems.

This makes understanding the qualifications obtained in other European countries easier for **employers** and **educational institutions**.

For learners and workers, who wish to work or study abroad, this helps describe their educational background, as well as obtained skills and knowledge, in a more transparent manner.
